Next Tuesday 12 November, the annual Library Bookfair commences for a week. It is a good opportunity to consider purchasing reading material for children.

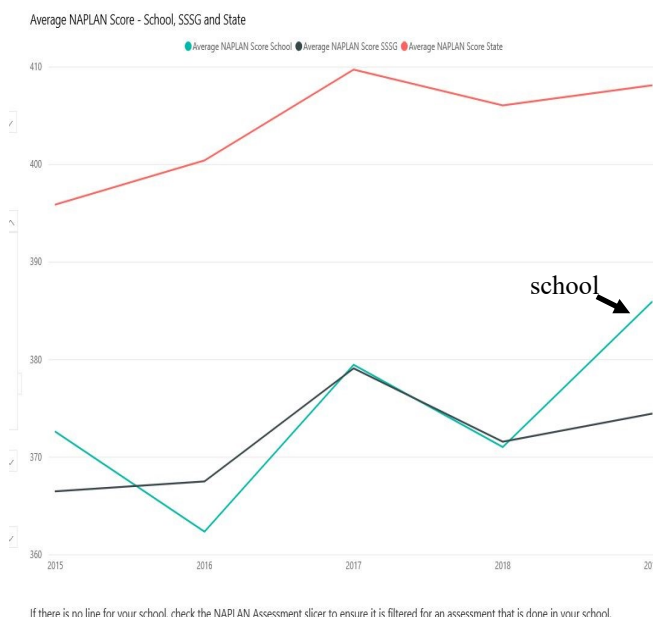
Staff Training

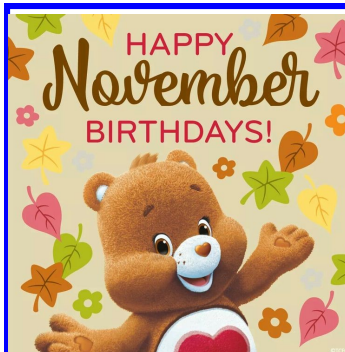

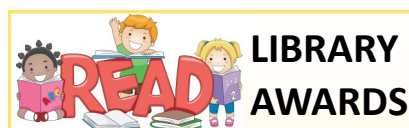

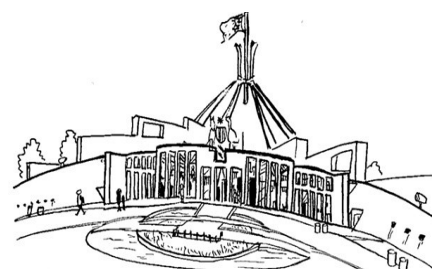
