**Early Arrivals** - There have been a number of students arriving very early - before 8:30am - there is no formal supervision or legal right for students to arrive before 8:30am. **Parent Parking/Drop-off** - The only place for parents to park or drop-off in the zone out the front in Evans St or general parking spaces in Murray and Evans St. No parent cars are permitted in staff car parking at anytime.

**Student Crossings** - Students and parents are reminded the crossing blisters are the safest places to use to cross Murray, Evans and Campbell Streets. The P&C has been working with the Traffic Committee to upgrade the safety along Campbell Street but there are still high risks, especially when students do not look before crossing.

### School Voluntary Contributions and Library Fund.
