Thank you to all families who are supervising your children at home with their learning plans as it helps to reduce the likelihood of a spread of the virus. There is no concern of that at Moruya PS at this point and if it does occur the school would be closed and “cleaned” forensically to ensure it can be re-opened again like it has happened at other schools.

So please keep sending your children to schools if you are working or need to for other reasons, it is a safe (and quiet) place - less than 10% of students at school. The same learning plan distributed last week is the learning plan at school or home. Those families who need hard copies of the learning plan please continue to come in and collect. Returning the paper copies to school for the teachers to mark would be appreciated. At this stage and into the future, all students absent are marked as Leave (approved) if you have contacted the school (either electronically or by phone) and your child/ren are completing the work online through Seesaw or by returning the paper copies. Only those families who have given no advice to the school will be marked as Unexplained absence.

The staff are working at school or at home, either developing new learning plans, marking and communicating with students/staff or doing their own online learning about how to provide online learning plans and communicating with students and staff. There is a skeleton staff onsite each day at school, enough to cater for all students attending.

My thoughts and prayers are with all families, students and staff as we all cope with this new arrangement, in particular, families and businesses that are struggling financially.
