

Student Wellbeing

We continue to implement the Bounce Back program with a focus on developing resilience. Dealing with the trauma of the bushfire season and COVID-19 presents a challenge for all of us including our children. We'll continue to support all students however, if you have any concerns or would like additional support please do not hesitate to contact myself or your child's teacher. We are here for you and your family and know that the best outcomes for children are always achieved when schools and families work together.

Bushfire Support for Families

Catholic Care have advised us that they are offering up to 10 free counselling sessions for individuals, couples and/or families in bushfire affected areas. Their program offers evidence based and trauma informed therapeutic services. You do not need a GP referral. You can contact them on 1800 068 698 to discuss possible options.



At the moment, where parent and family access to the school grounds is limited due to physical distancing measures, we are looking at additional ways in which we can keep you involved in the school's activities and your child's learning. We intend to continue to use Seesaw however, we are also hoping to connect more via Facebook. This may include photos and videos of school activities. This week a permission to publish form will be sent home with each child. It will explain the purpose and use of any images. Please return this form at your earliest convenience. It is different to our general permission form. If you would like further information or to discuss this in more detail please do not hesitate to contact me.



We have made the decision to cancel all overnight excursions for this year. While restrictions may change later in the year we are conscious of the financial pressure that may be caused if families are required to pay large amounts of money for an excursion with a short amount of notice. A lot of time is also required to organise excursions and this has not been possible this year either. If you have paid any money refunds will be issued. Money will also be refunded for the excursion planned to the Shoalhaven Entertainment Centre. We know that this is extremely disappointing and will endeavour to organise local day activities if possible later in the year.

This has changed for some classes from last term.


Students may also borrow and return during Afternoon Tea time on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday.
