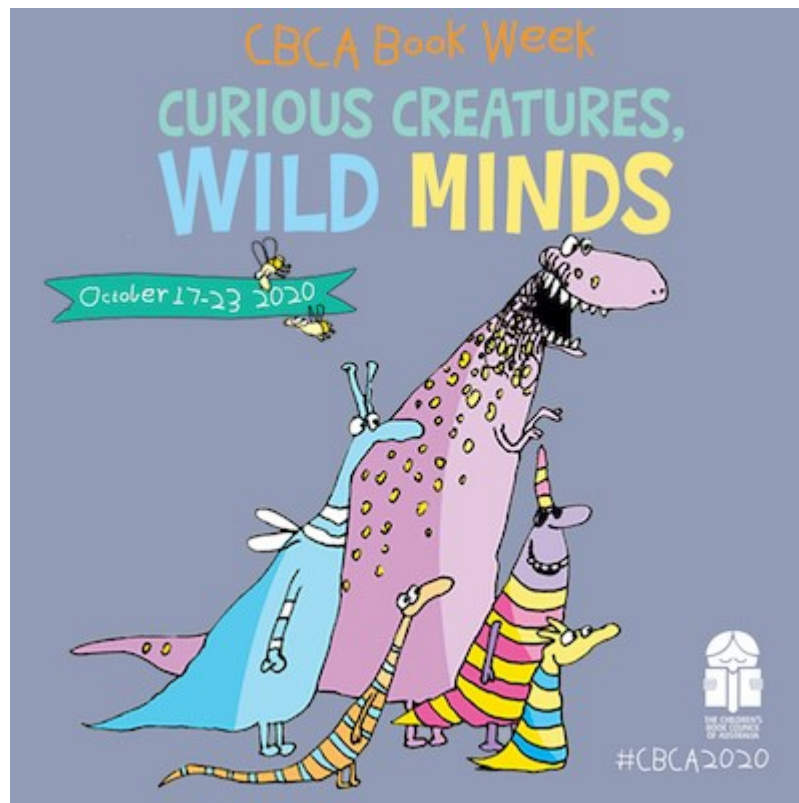
Performance Roster
