This week students in Years 3-6 will participate in a reading and numeracy Check-in assessment. The Check-in assessment is a NSW Department of Education online reading and numeracy assessment available to support schools to assess and monitor student learning. The assessments supplement existing school practices to identify how students are performing and to help teachers tailor their teaching more specifically to student needs. This information will be used to support all students in their learning at school. Students with disability may receive the same level of support during the assessment that they would normally receive in the classroom.


#### Attendance

Thank you to all families in supporting positive attendance for students following the return to school. Unless students are unwell they should be at school each day. Please be advised that students who have cold or flu symptoms are required to stay at home until they are symptom free and have a negative COVID test. Where a COVID test is not obtained the student must remain home for 10 days and also be symptom free. If your child is away, the absence needs to be explained within 7 calendar days or it is recorded as an unjustified absence. In order to assist families in explaining absences we have started to send daily text messages to all families who have a child absent from school. You can simply reply to this text to explain your child's absence and the information will be passed on to the class teacher. If your mobile phone number has recently changed please contact our office to update your details.

#### Tell Them From Me student survey:

Information for parents and consent form for parents and carers



#### Dear Parents and Carers

This term, our school is taking part in the *Tell Them From Me* student survey. The survey will provide us with valuable feedback on what our students think about school life, how engaged they are with school and the different ways that teachers interact with them. Schools in Australia and around the world have used the *Tell Them From Me* survey to help them improve. The survey is completed online and is run by an independent research company, **The Learning Bar** which specialises in school-based surveys.

Staff in schools will <u>not</u> be able to identify individual students from their responses. To ensure confidentiality, participating students will receive a unique username and password. Where fewer than five students respond to a question, the results will be suppressed. The survey typically takes 30 minutes or less to complete and will be administered by the school during normal school hours. Once the surveys are completed by students, reports are prepared and in most cases are available to schools within three business days.

This survey will help our school better understand how to improve student wellbeing and engagement. It will help the school identify what works to improve student outcomes.

Participating in the survey is entirely voluntary. Your child will not take part if either you or your child do not wish. If, during the survey, your child is uncomfortable, he/she can choose to stop the survey at any time. The majority of questions in the survey can be skipped.

If you <u>do not want your child to take part</u> in the survey, please complete the attached form and return it to the school by Wednesday 3 November.

#### **School Travel for 2022**

#### Applications are now open

Students who need a travel pass for 2022 can apply now https://transportnsw.info/school-travel-apply

A new application will need to be submitted if they are applying for a school travel pass for the first time, or if they are requesting an additional travel entitlement as a result of a new shared parental responsibility situation (e.g. joint custody). Students who change address or school or who have repeated a year or received an expiry notification from Transport for NSW for their school travel entitlement should renew or update their details before the end of term 4. Students living in rural and regional areas should receive their travel pass at the start of the new school year from their nominated transport operator. It may come via the school or be sent directly to them at home. Bus operators are flexible and understanding, particularly at the start of the school year, and will ensure students can travel safely to and from school. But to best support our operators we encourage all students to have a valid pass, as early as possible, from the start of the school year.
