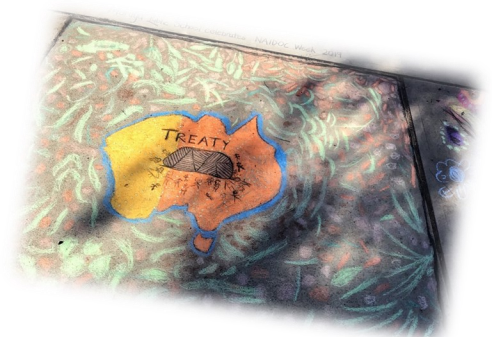
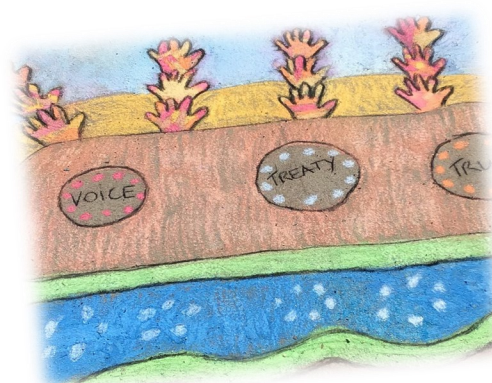

Slippers can be worn during class time, please make sure children have appropriate footwear for playtime.

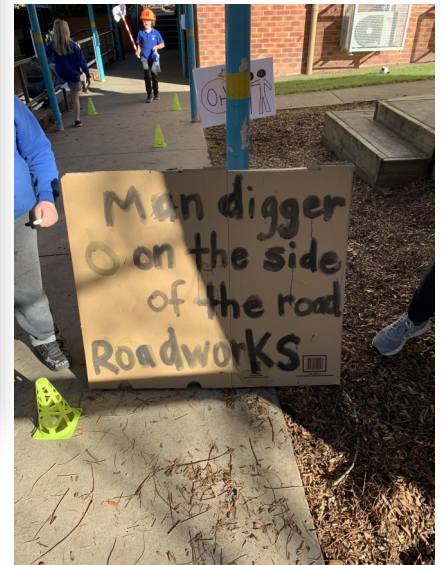
