



PEER SUPPORT

The whole school participates in Peer Support for 30 minutes each week. Each group have a supervising staff member.

Last week we commenced our Peer Support lessons. Two or three Peer leaders facilitated a small group of 12-14 younger students, who work together through a number of structured activities. We worked on a module called *Being Positive* helping us explore the concept of optimism. The module runs for eight sessions. Our first session enabled the children to get to know everyone in the group, agreeing on how they will work well together and interact cooperatively with others. They also began to think about what it means to be optimistic.

We encourage you to talk to your children about Peer Support every week, as it will help to reinforce the concepts learnt in each session. Congratulations to our Year 6 Peer Support leaders who did an outstanding job leading their first session!

This week in Peer Support the children will share the things they enjoy in life and have an opportunity to discuss their favourite activity. This session enables children to recognise what makes them happy. Discuss with your child their favourite activity.


If your child is absent from school you can *reply to the SMS* we send out between 10-11am. You do not need to notify the school in any other way that they are absent.


